A few years ago, I attended the Adelaide Hills Dressage Club's Spring Championships and watched a very beautiful grey stallion compete at Novice level. At the time, I thought 'Wow, that one has potential! I wonder where he will be in a few years time?'

As history shows, under the careful guidance of his knowledgeable and sensitive rider, Karen Horsell, 'Guizo' is now performing very successfully at Big Tour level. He is only 11, so they are just at the beginning of their Grand Prix journey.

I was asked by Dressage SA to write a story about this wonderful partnership and I can honestly say that I feel very honoured to do so. I have always loved Guizo and after visiting the Portuguese School of Equestrian Art in Lisbon, Portugal in 2018, I was fascinated by this noble and intelligent Iberian breed, the Lusitano. I met up with Karen recently and learned that she is a very talented artist with an interesting life outside of horses. As often is the case with Dressage riders, there is a lot more to them than meets the eye and this is certainly the case with this remarkably talented lady.

KAREN – A LIFE OF MORE THAN DRESSAGE

Karen was born in Adelaide and with non-horsey parents, started riding at 7 at the Fineview School of Riding run by Sarita Stratton (nee McDonald). It was there that she learnt about good basic horsemanship and her lifelong love of horses began. Her first pony was called 'Grandpa' and she learnt to master the not so gentle art of falling off with that little rascal. Apparently, Karen would enter Showjumping classes with enormous enthusiasm, only to find that Grandpa would refuse to go near the first fence as he believed that jumping at shows was not part of his agenda.

A variety of riding skills were learnt at an early age and by 12, she was eventing her first horse, Blackford Gilmorro (Gilly), a first cross Andalusian. This is where Karen's great interest in the Iberian horse commenced and she believes their impressive stature and great temperaments make them ideal riding horses for many people. Gilly was the

perfect equine partner to help her to establish confidence in a broad range of disciplines. At the age of 13, Karen met the wonderful Miguel Tavora and started her training journey with him.

This friendship with Miguel lasted for 35 years – he was her mentor in all aspects of riding and they developed a very unique partnership together. Even though he was a Dressage specialist, Miguel encouraged diversity with riding as he felt it was great for both horse and rider and this ethos also reflected his own riding career.

While riding Gilly in eventing and dressage, Karen started University and obtained a Bachelor of Education and Design. She decided that teaching was a great career to combine with horses and after graduation was employed by her old school, Westminster and has been teaching there ever since. “Technically, I have never left school”, she laughs. She was born with a natural talent for art and has followed her gift into many artistic areas. She did portraits to help pay for a Uni education, but her passion is for sculpture. She has done significant works in both bronze casting and ceramic sculpture and has exhibited in Fine Art exhibitions at Westminster.

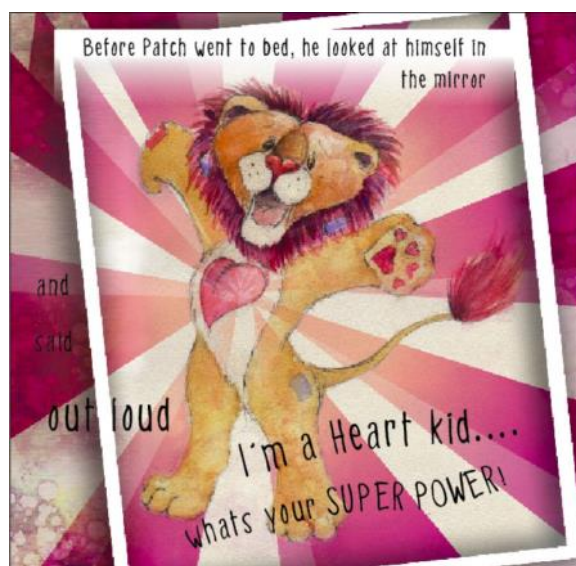


During her university training, Karen also started coaching in the equestrian field, with her main interest, of course, being Dressage. She has a great passion for teaching young people and loves their positivity and forward-thinking attitudes. Her dedication to this aspect of her sport has recently been rewarded with Karen being named EA Coach of the Month for November, 2022. She has a small number of very talented pupils, who are really starting to excel in dressage, but with her very busy schedule, coaching is a relatively small part of her equestrian life.

FAMILY COMES FIRST

Stuart is her very supportive partner who fortunately loves the horses and came seriously on the scene in 2002. They are raising two children together. Their daughter displayed a talent for riding but never continued to pursue this interest. She is now in the middle of Uni studies, and prefers to have a sneaky ride on Guizo when she visits from Melbourne. Their beautiful son Josh was born with a serious congenital heart defect and the family has had a long history of supporting him through six open heart surgeries and many other major heart procedures. Josh is now doing well and Karen believes that this experience with him has taught her many life skills, including pragmatism, optimism

and that ‘just get on with life’ attitude. She also believes that her horses have given her the respite that she needed when life has thrown up its challenges over the years. During these difficult times, Karen formed a foundation called the “Patch the Heart Lion Foundation’ and developed a heart lion character to help and support children and families affected by Childhood Heart Disease. Karen illustrated a book - ‘Patch the Brave Heart Lion’ to help young families discuss difference and inclusivity on their heart journey.



After Gilly, Karen experienced the joys of riding a hot and sensitive Thoroughbred before moving to a black Andalusian cross, Koorong Park Alfredo, who also had a quirky personality with its own set of challenges. They reached Small Tour and her FEI

enthusiasm was starting to blossom. Her next partner was Hudson Kavalier and he really gave her the taste for the serious FEI work. Simultaneously, the idea to buy a purpose-bred Dressage horse, preferably of Iberian breeding, flourished in Karen's mind.

FINDING GUIZO

Miguel and Karen had remained very good friends over the years and as Miguel was writing his own Dressage training book, Karen was the obvious choice to illustrate it for him. She did all the diagrams and illustrations for 'Dressage Principles and Techniques – A Blueprint For The Serious Rider' and the friendship blossomed further over this period. Karen had fallen in love with the Lusitano breed because of their temperament and movement and said to Miguel "I want to import a stallion from Portugal". It is well known that he was virtual royalty in the Portuguese horse scene, so with his many contacts over there, the intrepid travellers set off to visit lots of small studs around the country.

The first time Karen set eyes on Guizo was at the Golega Fair, a large Festival held annually for horses and their enthusiastic followers. It was love at first sight. After being given the thumbs up in the indoor arena, the new partners headed off around the fairground which was packed with people, horses and carriages in an equivalent setting to Sideshow Alley at the Royal Adelaide Show. Did Guizo care? NO! Was Karen enthralled with his temperament, his great initial training and the basic trust he had in his rider? A BIG YES!

The deal was done and the 4 year old Guizo arrived safely in Australia in March 2016. After a well earned rest, the pair started training and this progressed smoothly under the intermittent guidance of Miguel.

Blessed with a great Grand Prix pedigree, excellent type and a wonderful attitude towards his work, his progress towards Small Tour in 2019 was relatively straight forward.

Karen describes him as “a lovely person, obliging, very sensitive, an absolute tryer” and she has worked very hard to keep his lightness, self-carriage and sensitivity during his training. They reached Big Tour in 2022 and now Karen wishes to keep improving the partnership and the relationship that

they have developed over the years. Karen's wonderfully down to earth attitude towards life is exemplified by her words: “I really like to present the partnership I have with my horse rather than focusing on competition”.

Notwithstanding that, they already are consistently scoring well over 60% at Big Tour level with outstanding results at the recent Australian

Dressage Championships in Victoria. This humble attitude that Karen has, makes her a wonderful role model for her younger pupils as she leads the way by example. And who will ever forget their breathtaking performance at Sue Trigg's funeral, both in the arena and in the majestic procession around the beautiful McLaren Park? This event said it all about their partnership - good training, harmony and mutual understanding.



GUIZO THE BREEDING STALLION

Guizo is also a breeding stallion now licensed for the Portuguese Lusitano Stud Book. He is available to a limited number of approved mares by frozen semen only. These horses are very intelligent and talented but need clear boundaries during their training. They are now having great success in International Dressage competitions and are also being used to an increasing degree over Warmblood mares in northern Europe. Karen has a few of his offspring in the wings, but as Grand Prix is their main focus at the moment, she considers her breeding programme to be quite low key.

SOME WORDS OF WISDOM FROM AN EDUCATOR

- ◆ Respect the horse and he will respect you
- ◆ If it ain't broke, don't fix it – this particularly applies to Karen's consistently correct and insightful training programme and loyalty that she has displayed over the years to Westminster School and her coach and mentor, Miguel Tavora
- ◆ Horses don't forget - both good and bad things – in spite of all the interruptions and distractions, forward progress in Guizo's training still occurred
- ◆ Display kindness and firmness with a horse; its welfare is paramount
- ◆ Aggressive or cruel riding can never be tolerated
- ◆ Use a consistent, methodical and logical training programme
- ◆ Always listen to your horse's responses

Thank you, Karen, for our wonderful chat the other day. On behalf of the SA Dressage community, we wish you every success with your gorgeous boy and look forward to watching you both dance your way through your tests for many years to come.

Karen would like to particularly thank her mother for her invaluable and continued support over many years, her partner Stuart Martin for supporting her passion for horses, and to Jo Taylor (Southern Vales Dressage Club Wonder woman) for her unwavering help during a very tricky time when the family was in Melbourne with Josh.

Dressage SA Riders' Representative Roles and Responsibilities

EOI close March 3rd 2023

The Riders' Representative is a voluntary position and will be co-opted to the DSA Committee for two years unless they already hold a position on the Committee. If there is more than one applicant, they will be voted in by the ESA members who are Dressage competitors. The Riders' Representative must be an ESA member and be a current Dressage rider.

Key Responsibilities:

- ◆ facilitate a Riders' Forum
- ◆ to act as a focal point for riders to enquire about any aspects of competitions or concerns regarding policies, rules etc. and to provide information and answers for simple enquiries, ensuring compliance with the governance framework including the Dressage Rules, By-Laws, General Regulations, relevant EA and FEI documents, ESA policies and procedures
- ◆ to act on behalf of riders and to communicate riders' concerns in a timely manner to officials and/or the Dressage Committee of SA, Executive Officer or the ESA Board where the matter cannot be resolved as a simple enquiry
- ◆ to ensure riders' confidentiality is maintained at all times to enable riders to express their concerns
- ◆ to treat all riders concerns with empathy and in a respectful and professional manner
- ◆ to note, where a rider has a complaint against another rider the role of the Riders' Representative is to advise on the avenues of complaint available to the rider but not to act on their behalf
- ◆ to advocate for riders and be a conduit to officials and the National Riders' Representative

Key Knowledge, Abilities and Experience:

- ◆ a good working knowledge of the EA Dressage Rules, ESA Constitution, EA and ESA Bylaws, ESA and Dressage SA policies and procedures
- ◆ ability to act impartially and ethically
- ◆ ability to follow up and to ensure issues are resolved appropriately, in a timely manner and within the framework set by the governance documents
- ◆ ability to keep the rider informed of progress and outcome
- ◆ good literacy and communication skills
- ◆ good understanding of the complaints process via Sports Integrity Australia

It is important to note that the role of the Riders' Representative does not prevent any competitor from approaching Officials, Organising Committees, the Dressage Committee of SA, ESA Executive Officer or the ESA Board directly with a concern.

President's Report

Happy New Year everyone and best wishes for a healthy and successful year ahead.

The 2022 AGM was held during the lunch break at our December competition and the Committee remains the same, with one new member. We gratefully welcome Sheila Lewis to the team and acknowledge her experience and dedication from past years on the Committee.

Unfortunately the January 8th Competition had to be cancelled due to extremely hot weather. Our Hot Weather Policy is to cancel if the forecast for Strathalbyn is 35 degrees or above on the Friday night on the BOM App. We are keeping our fingers crossed for the February Combined Training Day!!!

AHDC and SSJC have invested \$5,000 each to help pay for the new K Line Pod Irrigation System. The travelling sprinklers previously used were high maintenance, labour intensive and costly to run. One sprinkler broke down over the Christmas break and the part needed was no longer available. Graham Brook our Groundsman) fixed it temporarily but had to move the sprinklers manually, which is very time consuming.

The total cost of the new system is around \$20,000 so hopefully we will make a substantial profit from the grounds Fundraiser Combined Training Day on 29th January to contribute to the remainder owed. Daish have kindly agreed to help with a payment plan if needed. The system should be all up and running by the time this report goes online.

The Government Grant Application for a new toilet block has been lodged and if successful, we have explored several options. Many thanks to Viv McLean and Rod Angel for the effort they have put into researching these options. More info on that next time.

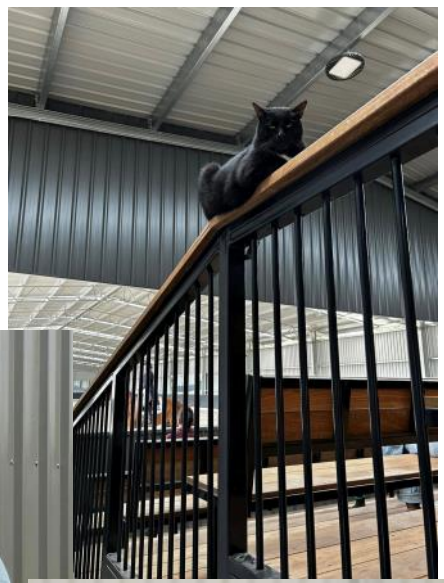
